The Children's Health Queensland (CHQ) Board held its July meeting at the Assertive Mobile Youth Outreach Services (AMYOS) and Eating Disorders Day Program community site in Chermside. The Board welcomed presentations by the Statewide Community Adolescent Extended Treatment (AET) Program teams about AMYOS, Youth Residential and Rehabilitation Services, and the Eating Disorders Day Program.
