The Children's Health Queensland (CHQ) Board held the September Board meeting at the Queensland Children's Hospital. The meeting was chaired by David Gow, who paid respect to the Traditional Owners of the lands on which we walk, talk, work and live.

The Board recognised the Executive Leadership Team for the exceptional work on the financial audit and annual reporting. The Deputy Board Chair acknowledged the success of the joint Board and Executive Leadership Team meeting with Health and Wellbeing Queensland and recognised the Executive Director Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Engagement for the inspiring presentation on First Nations Health Equity.

The Board Chair provided the following updates:

- The expectations of the Minister for Health and Ambulance Services of the government health system for the coming year.
- The Finance and Internal Audit teams were recognised for their contributions to the 2022 financial audit for Children's Health Queensland.

The Board received a comprehensive update from the Health Service Chief Executive on a range of matters, including:
