Treatment is supportive:

Target Sats 92% or above

Nasal High flow is
indicated if persistently hypoxic

and moderate
to severe recessions.



Fluid

NG hydration or
IV Isotonic Fluid is appropriate.
Ideal volume is unproven.
Consider nutrition as well
as hydration.

These interventions won't change outcomes:

Salbutamol Corticosteroids Adrenaline Hypertonic Saline Antibiotics Chest Physiotherapy Antivirals Viral PCR testing

Risk factors for more serious illness:

Gestation < 37 weeks
Chronological age < 10 weeks
Post natal smoking exposure
Breast fed < 2 months

Failure to thrive
Chronic Lung Disease
Congenital Heart Disease
Chronic neurological conditions
Indigenous ethnicity
