Children's Health Queensland is currently inviting parents and carers to join a consumer group supporting the work of the Child Health Service.

What is it?

Children's Health Queensland (CHQ) is setting up a new consumer group for families who use the Child Health Service.

This group will work with CHQ staff to help achieve family-centred improvements to the Child Health Service.

Consumers involved will have the opportunity to:

- Share your thoughts and feedback on the experience of families accessing the Child Health Service
- Be involved in creating ideas for how the service can be improved to better meet families needs

Who can join?

CHQ is seeking people who:

- Have attended the Child Health Service this year
- Want to make a difference to health services for families
- Can join an online meeting using a telephone or computer/smartphone (CHQ can help you set this up)

You can participate from wherever suits you as this is an online group.

We especially encourage those who identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander or culturally or linguistically diverse to support the diverse of experience of the panel.

What's involved?

Group members will participate in a one-hour online meeting to discuss the Child Health Service from a family perspective. A phone call before the meeting will let group members know what to expect and will give you the heads up of what the group will be discussing.
