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Workflow Changes

ESM “Searches / Inquiries” window

In the ESM “Searches / Inquiries” window, the application will now store “User recent searches”. Recent searches will be added automatically as the user clicks through the list.

Pre-Upgrade



Post-Upgrade (note: ‘recents’ above the dotted line)



User Information:

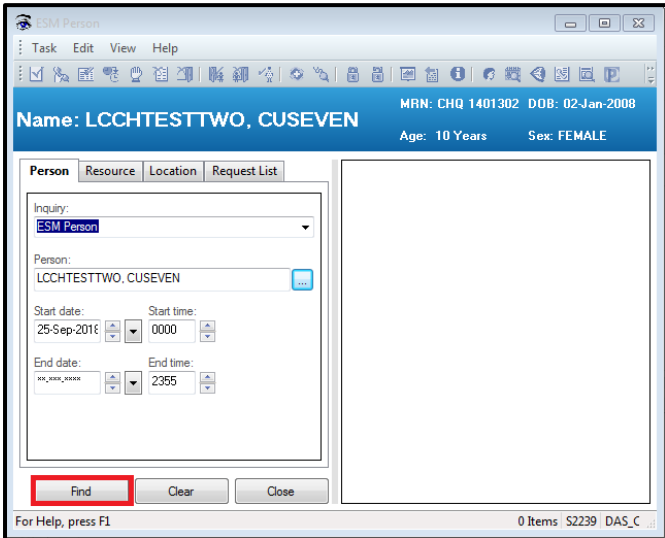
To remove a ‘recent’ search, highlight and select the ‘delete’ key

The Person Search dialog box re-launches when pressing <enter> after selecting a patient

Issue occurs on Schedule Inquiry window > Person tab. When a patient is chosen in the filter and the user presses 'enter' on the keyboard, the person search window reappears.

User Information

Click on 'Find' button to initiate the search or press 'Tab' key until the focus is on the 'Find' button then press 'Enter' on keyboard.



Filtered search window does not appear upon clicking ellipses in ESM

This only occurs on Schedule Inquiry > Resource and Location tab. Clicking the ellipses button does not launch the Filtered search window if the Resource Group (Resource Tab) or Location Group (Location tab) field is left blank.

User Information

Type an * in the Resource Group or Location Group field and click on ellipsis button to open the search window.
